

START, SIAC

Same procedure as in sprint

- Clear (-4 min.) and check (-3 min) of SIAC for own responsibility. An electronic start line Air+ will be used to record the exact start time.
-the competitor may start any time between five seconds before the start signal and the start signal. If a competitor starts late, the start list time is taken as the start time. (Rule 22.19)
- At -2 min an additional control station is placed for a test punch.

FINISH

- Same procedure as in sprint
- Direcly on ski stadium
- No punching at the finish line. The finish time is taken when the competitor pass the marked finish line.
- Equipment in closed ski-bags on stadium nearby start
