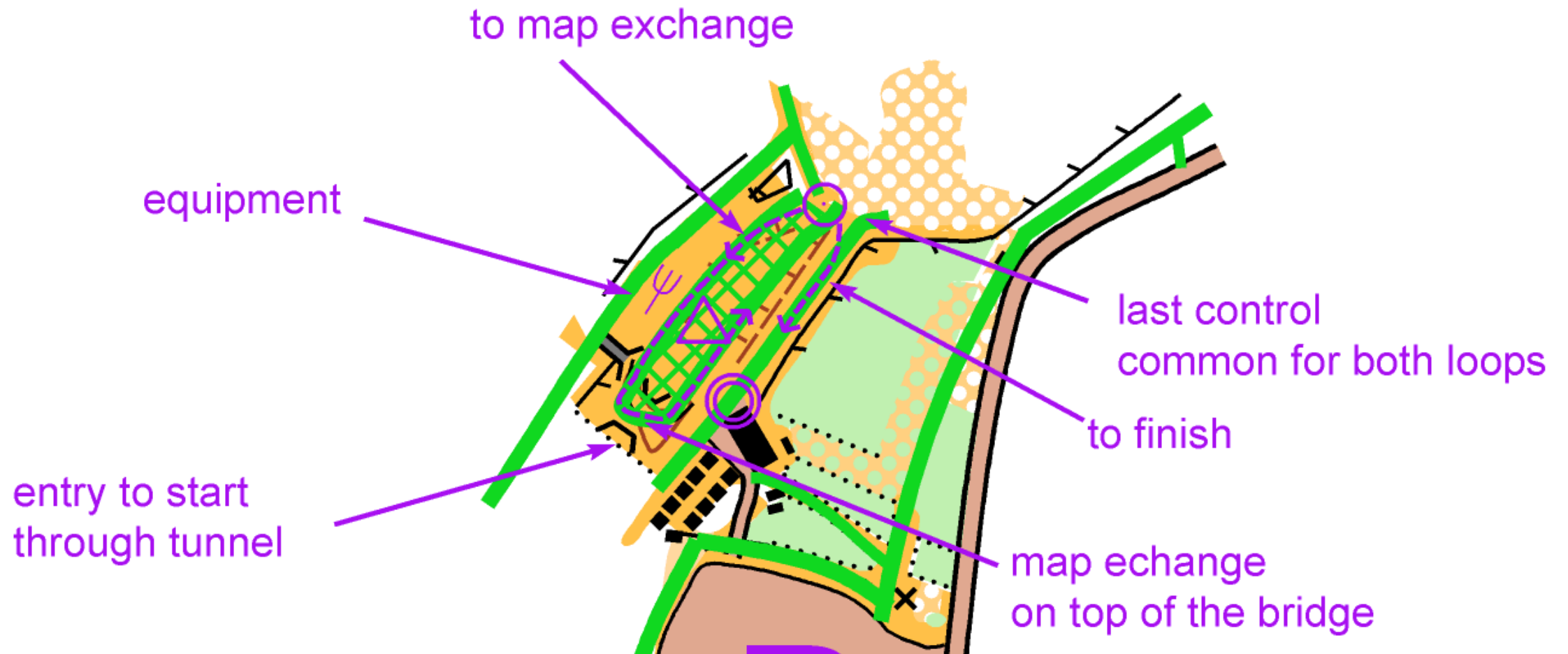

COURSES

- update:
 - Women:
 - 10,6 km, shortest sensible route choice 15,7 km, no. of controls 15, climbing 510 m
 - Men:
 - 13,4 km, shortest sensible route choice 18,8 km, no. of controls 22, climbing 710 m

TRACK / TERRAIN

- 85 % full line – wide track made by big machine
- 10 % dashed line – made by quad
- 5 % dotted line – made by skiers

TRACK / TERRAIN

- black road on map – was prepared by quad (like dashed line), but is harder and slightly wider = quite good to ski



MAP

- 1:15.000, E 5 m
- size A4
- printed on synthetic paper Pretex

START, SIAC

- Same procedure with SIAC as in sprint and middle
- 2 competitors start for 2 different loops
- Map exchange – at stadium

FINISH

- Same procedure as in sprint and middle
- Directly on ski stadium
- No punching at the finish line. The finish time is taken when the competitor pass the marked finish line.
- Equipment – in closed ski-bags on stadium nearby start
